Established in 2009, the Sioux Falls Seminary Center for Lifelong Learning provides opportunities for continuing education to the community. A variety of programming in the areas of Bible, theology, Christian community development, ministry, and more is offered throughout the year.

## 1 certificate in christian ministry

- designed for those seeking theological and practical training for service in Christian ministry, this program gives students exposure to the basic core concepts and skills necessary for day-to-day Christian ministry.

- ideal for those who choose not to pursue or are not eligible for training at the graduate level.

## 3 women in community

- a series of seminars designed for women in ministry and business leadership positions that offer the opportunity to come together to reflect and renew their calls to ministry and enrich their relationships with one another.

- Previous seminars have focused on reflecting on the call to serve, mentoring, and the empowerment of story.

## 2 discipleship sioux falls

- teaches individuals about the Christian story and the role they play within it and helps them develop a new and deeper understanding of the Bible, faith, and how their story fits into God's story.

- offers the chance to interact with Sioux Falls Seminary faculty members to learn more about the Christian faith.

## 4 young christian leaders series

- a series of events for young Christian leaders aimed at offering personal and professional enrichment.

- gatherings are a great opportunity for young professionals to connect with one another.

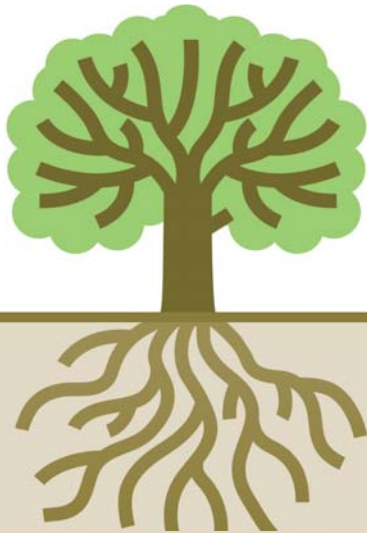

## 1 center for lifelong learning

- entry-level, non-credit, Christ-centered education that does not require undergraduate work for admission
- now offering: Certificate in Christian Ministry and Discipleship Sioux Falls—Certificate in Community Development coming soon
- additional programming ranging from one-day seminars to additional certificate programs to be added

## 2 graduate courses and programs

- audit graduate-level courses, in person or online, for only \$50 per credit hour
- flexible/online course and program options
- distance learning for M.Div. and MACL
- offerings at various credit levels

## 3 continuing education

- graduate or non-credit courses can be taken/audited for personal enrichment
- Doctor of Ministry program for those with M.Div. and three years ministry experience
- seminars and workshops are offered throughout the year on a variety of topics that can be broadcast live over the Internet or played back at a later date
